

Spring is just around the corner, and Camp Liberty is now launching our 2017 programs where volunteers can assist our veterans by helping maintain and prepare the buildings and grounds for the programs that benefit our veterans. This year, over 50 recreation programs are planned with many being held at Camp Liberty.

Over the years, volunteers have made our work days a huge success by helping with the restoration of our bridge, the construction of our Lodge, and the building of our Program Center. We are again inviting volunteers to help with current needs, both large and small.

VOLUNTEER DAYS – MARCH 25 AND APRIL 1

Numerous organized volunteer days are set up over the next few months. On Sat., March 25 and Sat., April 1, from 9 am to 3 pm, we will be working mostly on our Program Center. This includes light carpentry work, installing locks, remove construction waste, maintain equipment, install electrical wiring and lights, and construct the indoor shooting range. A team of electricians have volunteered to handle much of the wiring, but would like assistance with other tasks. Lunch/beverages provided.

CONSERVATION DAY – MAY 6

On May 6, we will hold our Fourth Annual Conservation Day. We will again plant fruit and evergreen trees, maintain the 80 fruit trees previously planted, plant flowers around the Darlene Soave Lodge, remove downed trees, and clean our wildlife observation blinds. There will be tasks available for people of all levels of skill and experience. The Conservation Day will begin at 9:00 a.m. with a meeting in the Program Center. Lunch and beverages will be provided, and we will wrap up before 3:00 p.m.

In addition to these events, there are many other opportunities where individuals or groups can volunteer to assist with specific projects or tasks. Volunteers may perform the work based upon their own schedules. We have a long list of opportunities for volunteers to pitch in and help. 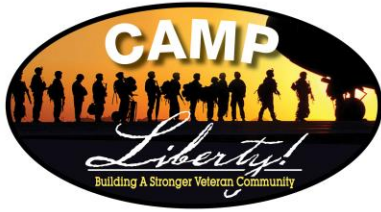

VOLUNTEER PROJECTS AND TASKS

Group Projects

1. A group of carpenters is needed to construct a gazebo that will serve as an outdoor chapel.
2. Paint the porch ceiling and cedar trim of the Lodge.
3. Install paver blocks on the new Lodge terrace.
4. Construct a tower shoot course

Conservation and Light Landscaping Work

- A. Use the tractor to cut pathways, rototill and plant food plots.
- B. Cut the grass around the buildings with the riding lawn mower.
- C. Water and spray recently planted trees.
- D. Fertilize and prune fruit trees and shrubs.
- E. Plant flowers around the property entrance and buildings.
- F. Plant pumpkins and vegetables for the veterans staying at the Lodge.
- G. Build brush piles for wildlife
- H. Install or relocate wildlife observation blinds.

Tasks for People that are Handy

- A. Build racks to store fishing rods and bows.
- B. Hang a cabinet mounted microwave oven
- C. Install a post formed countertop on some cabinets.
- D. Install a simple 30 sf ceramic tile backsplash.
- E. Organize shovels, rakes and tools
- F. Repair the doors on the shed.
- H. Wash windows
- I. Paint a door.

Hosting and food preparation workers are also needed to greet, check-in and feed the volunteers.
